**Justice and Mission** – Offering opportunities to learn and experience how to make a difference through serving and advocating for others. We seek to keep a spirit of unity prevalent, so we ask you to please avoid polarizing topics and agendas that tend to divide. There is a place for that but Youth 2011 is not that place.

**Worship Arts and Offerings**– Exploring different ways to use prayer, art, drama, music, media and our gifts as worship.

**Outreach/ Evangelism** – What is evangelism and how to effectively share God and reach others through social networking, telling our faith story, outreach events, and more.
